

Rules for Gardeners:

1. Once you plant your garden, you must continue to maintain it through harvest of all vegetables and clean-up.
2. WEEDS MUST BE KEPT UNDER CONTROL! Not many people like weeding, but it has to be done—no exceptions.
3. The Community Garden is shared by many people, please be respectful in keeping your plot maintained and free of tools, garbage and weeds surrounding your plot. A dumpster is available on site.
4. If you grow more vegetables than what you can use, we encourage you to donate excess fruit and vegetables to a local food pantry.
5. A minimal donation of \$20.00 is suggested to help keep the community garden growing year after year. The donation will be waived in limited circumstances.

2. Seeds and seedlings will be available for free (as supplies last) through donations from Olds Seeds, Antigo Country Store and Lincoln Hills Juvenile Detention Center Gardening Program
3. Gardening classes and garden mentors will be available to anyone needing assistance in getting started through harvest
4. Limited gardening tools and supplies will be available depending on funding. A shed will be available for limited storage
5. Water is available on site
