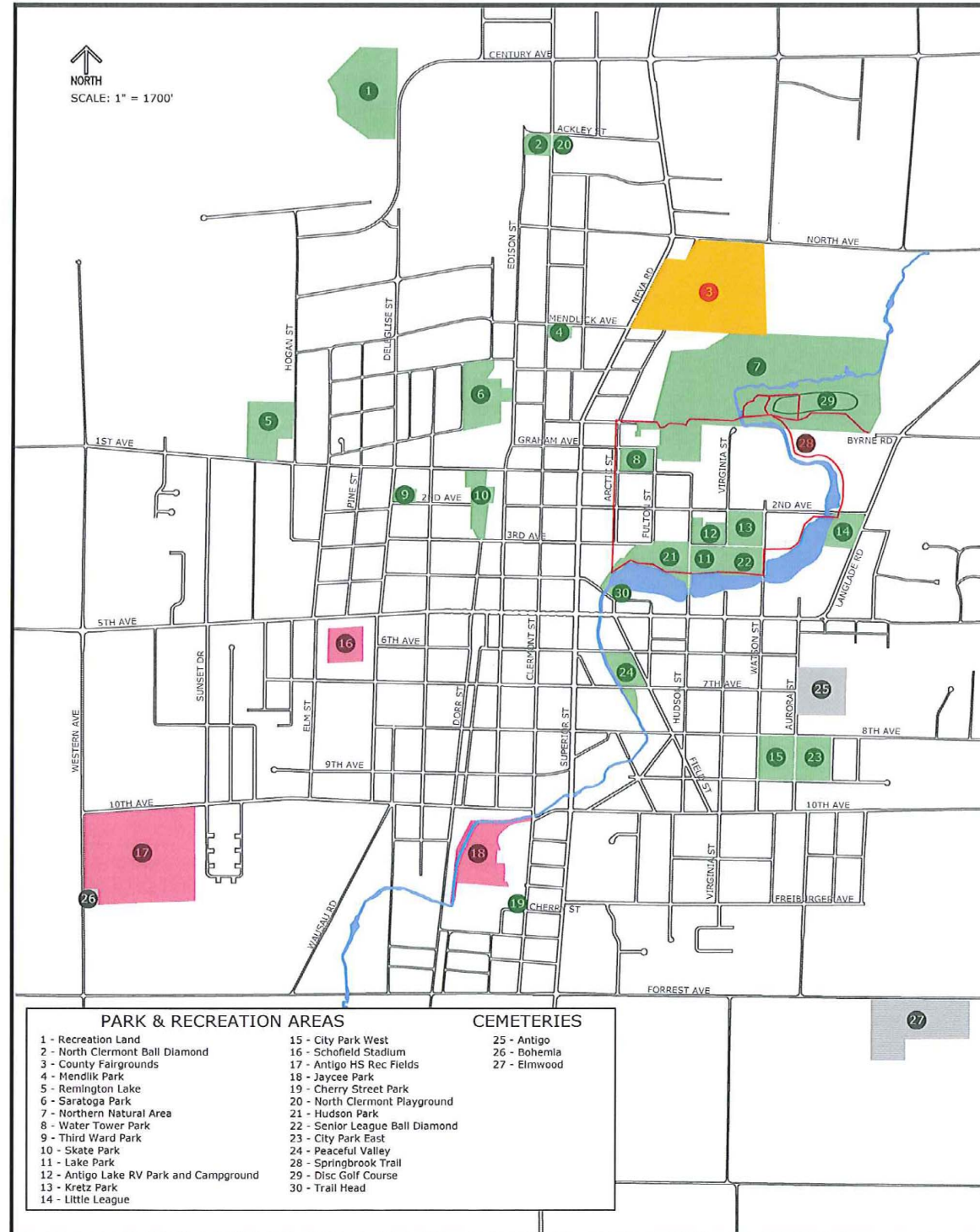

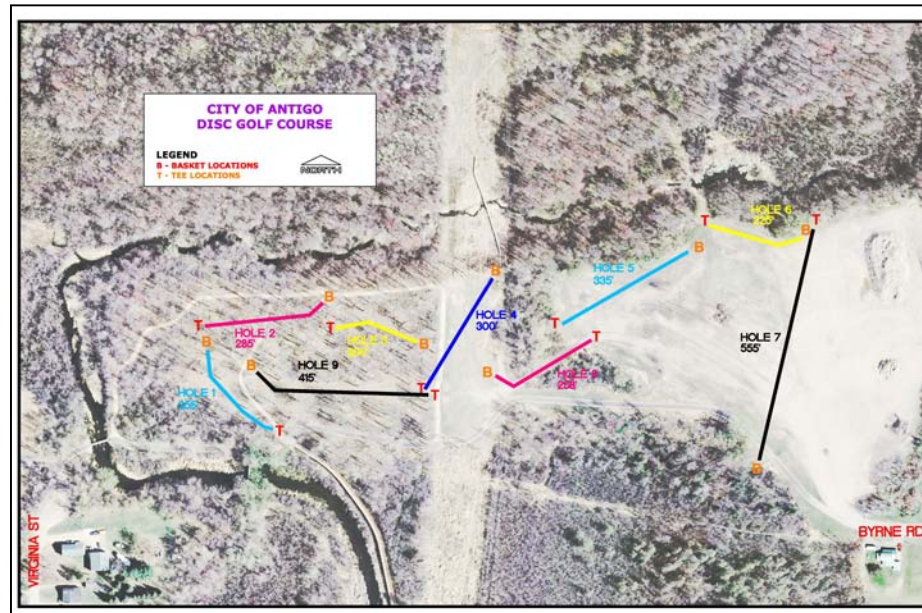
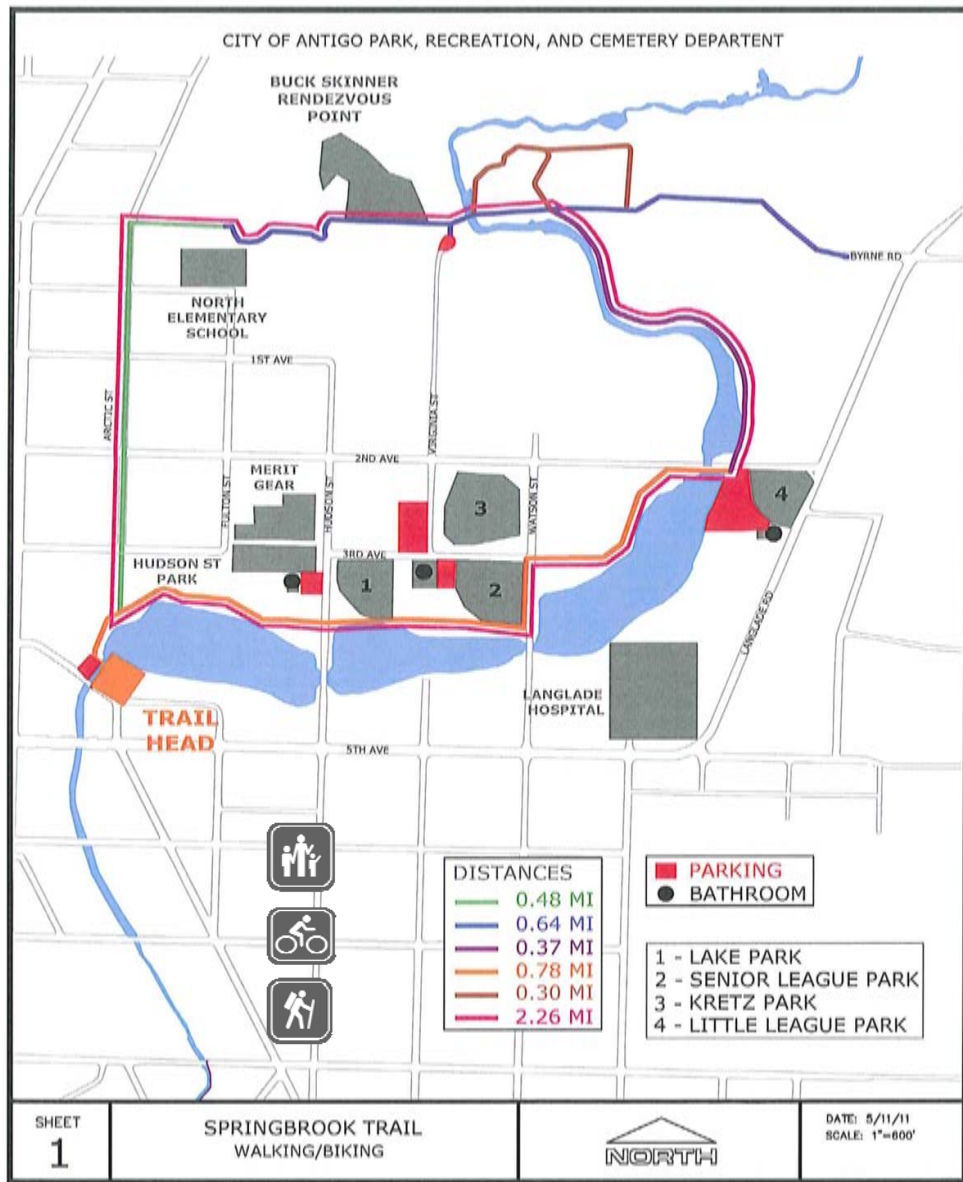

Dispose of trash in the provided waste containers.

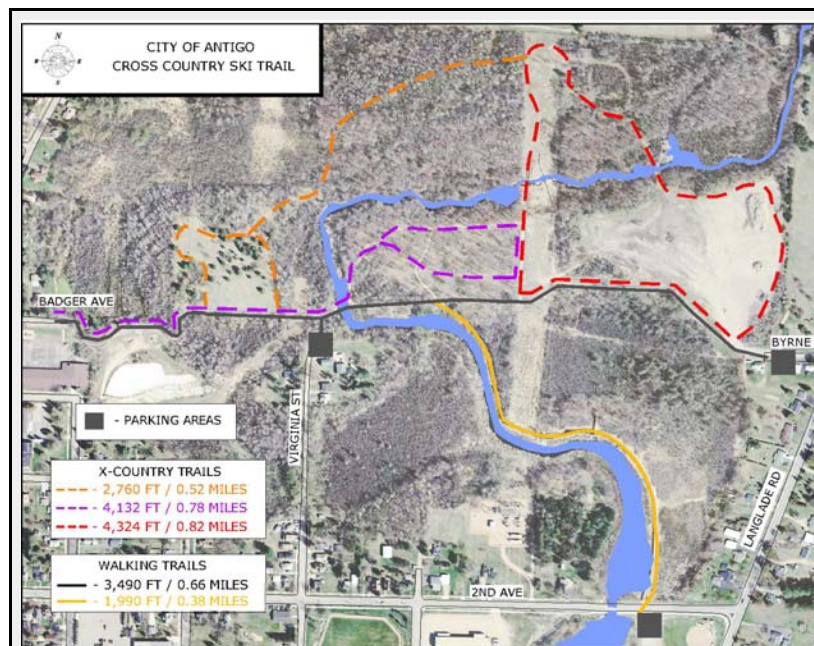
Have Fun!!!
