

Welcome to the Kettlebowl Cross Country Ski Trail. The trail is located on both Langlade County property and private property off Wisconsin Highway 52 about 15 miles northeast of Antigo. It is approximately 4.3 miles in length with the trail head in the northeast corner of the parking lot and on the Kent Fire Tower Road. Use Kent Fire Tower Road parking area Monday-Friday as the gate at the main entrance is locked.

### ***TRAIL DESCRIPTION***

The trail weaves its course through changing scenery of primarily northern hardwood and aspen forest types, which are typical of Langlade County. The topography includes high ridges and rolling hills.

### ***LOOPS***

The Kettlebowl Classic – The original. This trail, which weaves through an expansive hardwood forest, is designed for all ability levels. It is considered easy with a few rolling hills and an exciting downhill run.

Cutoff Canyon – This trail is a shortcut for skiers desiring a shorter outing. There is one steep run.

The Plum Creek Loop – This trail provides skiers with more distance. It features gentle rolling hills with a spectacular view of the surrounding forest. Caution this trail runs along the Kent Fire Tower Road for a short distance.

### ***FACILITIES***

The trail facilities include a parking area, restrooms, and a shelter with food. The shelter is only open weekends when the Kettlebowl ski hill is open.

### ***TIMBER HARVESTING***

The Langlade County Forest is comprised of 127,000 acres and is managed for timber, wildlife, recreation, and other multiple use benefits. The northern hardwoods timber type is harvested using selective logging which provides continuous and sustainable forest products. The aspen type is dependent upon full sunlight to regenerate itself which requires clearcutting to eliminate shade. You may encounter timber harvesting operations. The Kent Fire Tower Road is often plowed for winter logging activity, so skiers are urged to exercise caution. **Please use caution and respect the logger's equipment as they earn their livelihood.**

### ***DONATIONS***

### ***OTHER TRAILS***

Moccasin Lake – 2 miles west of Elcho on Moccasin Lake Road.

Jack Lake – 12 miles north of Antigo on Highway 45, then east on County J for 2 miles.

Gartzke Flowage – 9 miles east of Antigo on County Road F.

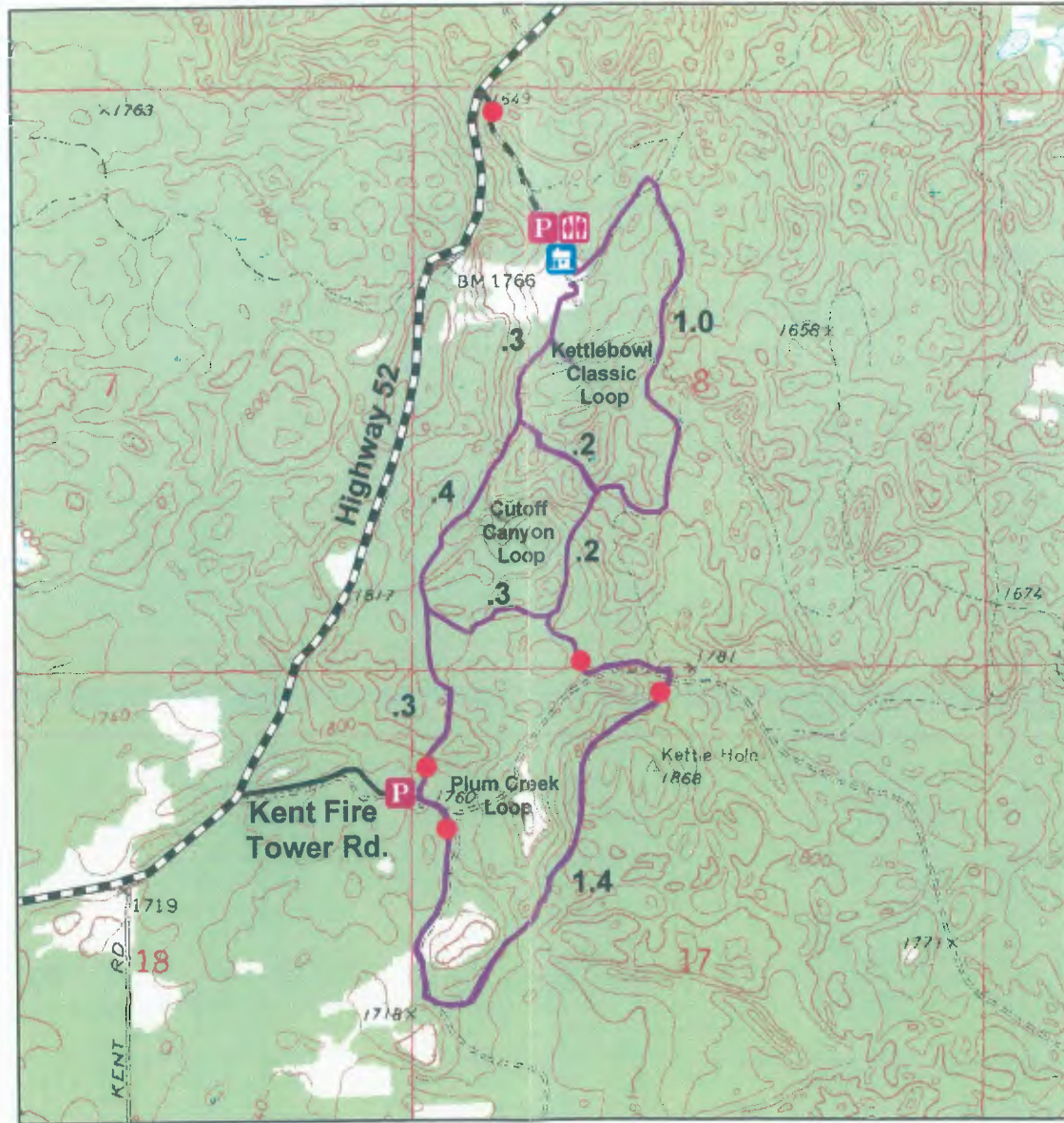
