GFWC-Wisconsin was chartered into the General Federation of Women's Clubs on October 20, 1886. The objective of GFWC-Wisconsin is to bring federated women's clubs of Wisconsin together, and to provide a networking system for these clubs with clubs from other state federations and GFWC headquarters.

There are six districts in Wisconsin including Lakeshore, Northern Lights, Northwoods, Rivers & Lakes, Rolling Hills, and Southern Prairies. District meetings are held in the spring and fall of each year. Districts host the event on a rotating basis.

Attendance at the annual Blended Marketplace typically exceeds 2,500 eager shoppers.

The annual Blended Marketplace Coordinator with the support of club members ensures show success through correspondence with crafters and vendors, registration, show layout and setup.

Club members contribute homemade bakery, candies, etc. for the Bake Sale. The show also features a raffle which is supported by the local community, crafters, vendors and club members.

Food and refreshments for the annual Blended Marketplace are provided by AVAIL, Inc. All proceeds from the annual Blended Marketplace are donated back to Langlade County area organizations.

Admission to the annual Blended Marketplace is \$3.00 or \$2.00 with a non-perishable item (items are donated to the Antigo Area Community Food Pantry).
