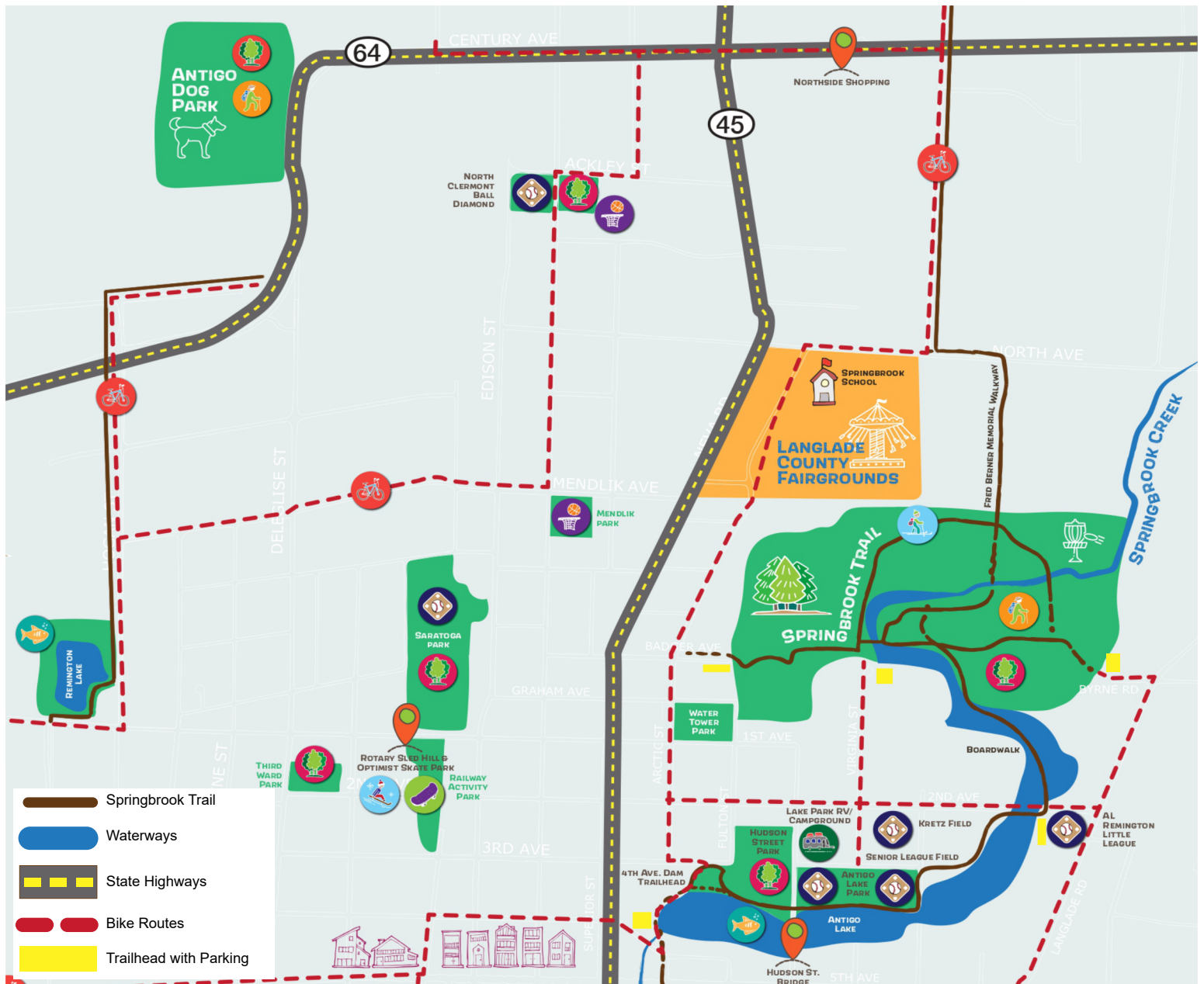


SPRINGBROOK TRAIL

IN THE HEART OF ANTIGO



The original Springbrook Trail was just over 2 miles and completed in 2010. It included an 1,800 foot boardwalk and woodchipped trails. The Springbrook Trail has now expanded to include a 420 foot low-level boardwalk and 2 bridges funded by the local Rotary club. Additional trail segments were constructed that run north along the east edge of the Fairgrounds property, north on Charlotte Street, and connect to Northstar Lanes. An additional segment runs on the west side of Hogan Street, and along Remington Lake. The trail is now just over 5 miles, and additional expansion plans are in place to create an east west connection along the Hwy 64 bypass. The paved trail is maintained in the winter time, and a 1 mile loop is groomed in the winter for cross-country skiers.

Bikes, roller-blades and walkers are welcome. Remember to be a courteous trail user – keep pets on a leash and pick up pet waste. Bike or walk on the right when the trail is busy or you are coming to a blind corner. Signal to those you are passing. Most importantly, enjoy the beauty of the Springbrook Trail!

A walk on the woodchipped loop in the northern natural area almost guarantees seeing deer and other wildlife.
